- LISA GRAY STATES SHE HAS A CONTACT FROM FBI THAT MAY BE WILLING TO BE A SPEAKER FOR A MEETING ABOUT THESE CONCERNS. MRS. BEICHLER SUGGESTED A LAW ENFORCEMENT PANEL FOR PARENTS.
